

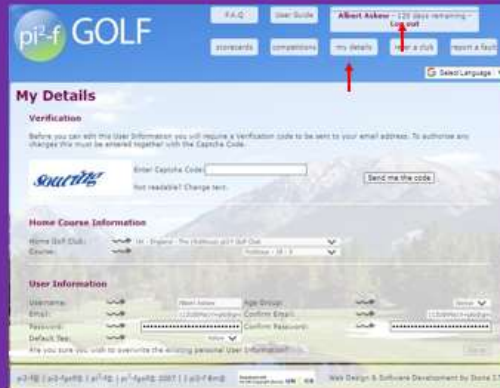

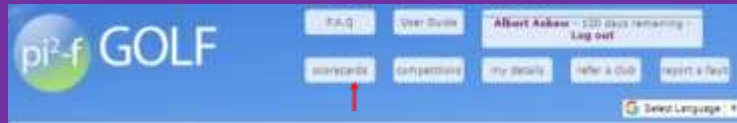

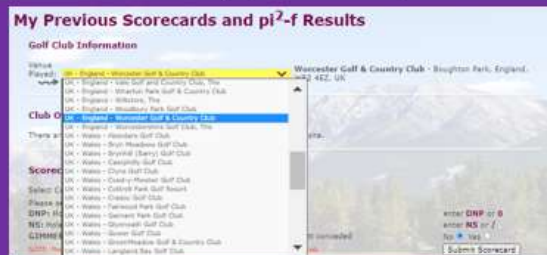
## ENTERING A SCORECARD

## ENTERING A SCORECARD

Select the Venue played from the drop-down list



The venue must be listed for the scorecard to be entered

Check in advance of playing and if not listed contact the club and politely request permission for it to be added. This will require the name of the official granting consent and their email.

## ENTERING A SCORECARD

Having requested and been given verbal consent

Click the REFER A CLUB tab

## ENTERING A SCORECARD

Enter the GROSS STROKES taken on each hole

**Scorecard Course Selection**

Select Course & Tee: Fictitious - 18 - Yellow

A value must be entered for all 18 holes. E.g. if a 9-hole course is only played once then enter a value of '0' (dnp) for each of the holes 10-18'. The website can only assess rounds played in the correct hole sequence (holes 1 - 18).

THE DATE ENTERED IS SO IMPORTANT THAT YOU ARE ALWAYS ASKED TO CHECK

A date EARLIER than the previous scorecard entered will not be accepted so always enter the oldest scorecard first

Once happy that the date and gross strokes are correctly entered click the OK BUTTON

#### ENTERING A SCORECARD

On clicking OK the unique algorithm uses all the data available to calculate what should be a NORMAL round for you.

It then provides an assessment of whether you played to your  
**NORMAL LEVEL OF GOLF**

**The assessment compares the round against yourself and the course**

As no other player is being compared no handicap is required to make you equal with anyone

You either played to your **NORMAL** level on that particular course  
Or better than normal (a **GOOD** or even a **SUPER** round  
Or worse than normal (a **POOR** or absolutely **DIRE** round)

**SCORECARD ASSESSMENT**



Albert had a POOR round that day mainly due to a very bad front 9. The Back 9 was played to the level expected of him.

What isn't known is how good Albert is. Does he play scratch golf or is he new to the game and not very good?

Both are irrelevant as walking off the course he will be thinking that was not a good round today though the Back 9 was OK

**SCORECARD ASSESSMENT**

This assessment is then added to all his others which the algorithm uses to re-calculate and update what is a normal round the next time he plays.

Visually, the more Blacks and Greys show the more his game is improving over that period. The more Reds and Pinks his game is struggling

**SCORECARD ASSESSMENT**

Clicking 25 and points translates this improvement over the last 25 rounds into numerical values

Black totals at the foot of the table indicates Albert's game has been steadily improving. Red totals declining

A BLACK total of 11 indicates that Albert's improvement has been mainly over the back 9 holes

**SCORECARD ASSESSMENT**

And that's it. The website assesses each round on the basis of whether he/she played the course better or worse than expected and makes no attempt to compare it with anyone else.

For this sole reason **HANDICAPS HAVE NO ROLE TO PLAY.**

And yet:

The website enables Albert to enjoy participating in competitions against other golfers at his club or indeed playing anywhere in the world (irrespective of age, gender or ability).

The only thing Albert needs to invite someone is their:  
**pi2-golf USERNAME**  
 or  
 the email they've registered with

### COMPETITIONS – WHO PLAYED BETTER THAN NORMAL

**Normal** Golf Competitions compare participants ACCORDING TO:

- 1a. Who took the LEAST GROSS STROKES
- 1b. Who took the LEAST NET STROKES (after their handicap allowance)
  
- 2 Who scored the MOST STABLEFORD POINTS (after their handicap allowance)

**Pi2-1** Golf Competitions compare participants ACCORDING TO :

1. Who's round was played BETTER THAN NORMAL

### COMPETITIONS

ALL WEBSITE COMPETITIONS ARE **FREE TO ENTER** AND **MUST NOT** REQUIRE AN ENTRY FEE from those invited to participate (see T&C)

Club officials are the **ONLY** exception (see T&C)

There are two types of competitions available


1 Participants' rounds tabulated from Best to Worst  
1 pt for the worst round  
2 pts for the next  
X pts for the best round (10pts for players 16pts for 16 players)  
These points are then accumulated after each round

2 An ECLECTIC  
The **best performance** on each hole over the whole competition  
These are then used to make up the **perfect 18 holes played** and tabulated



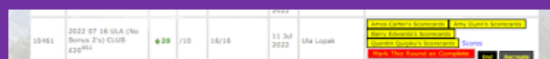

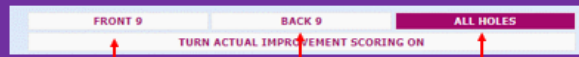

The competition is run according to tabulated points earned each round

HOWEVER,

There is an alternative table which lists whether players has been  
PLAYING ABOVE THEMSELVES  
during the competition to date

Unlike the usual pi2 competition this cannot include estimated rounds

So once a player fails to submit a scorecard for inclusion he she is  
automatically removed from the table

This can be explained by viewing the final scores of a previous competition

Over the course of the 10 rounds Peter has generally played better than everyone else with Charlene still second.

## ECLECTIC COMPETITIONS

An ECLECTIC competition can be created by selecting it together with penalty points

Unlike the main pi2-f competition this is based on each hole rather than 9 or 18 of them

The **best** assessment for each hole during the competition is selected

At the end of the 10 rounds the PERFECT SCORECARD is compiled to compare with the others

## ECLECTIC COMPETITIONS

The disadvantage is that of the current handicap systems

It is **EASIER** for a **weaker player** than a consistently good player to complete a hole in less shots than **NORMAL** during a multi-round competition

In recognition of this a **PENALTY** system is in place to penalise the winner of previous competitions. Over time the penalty will remove this bias

When a competition ends and a new one begins penalise the previous winner 4 pts

If the same person wins this as well penalise him/her 8 pts the next competition

Once every player has won and had penalty points reduce these for **ALL** players but **NOT TO 0**

Take an consensus value as the players will know from the points differences of the previous competition what would be fair. A player with an 8 point penalty finishing second just 3 points will not warrant his -8 being reduced at all let alone to 0

Despite a 4 point penalty Angela is still top after 3 rounds

The other players still have 7 rounds in which to play any hole **better than it has been so far** to close the gap with Angela

As with a usual stroke-based eclectic this becomes more difficult the less rounds available.
